Subject: Scholarship Scheme for Pakistani students under Thai International Cooperation Agency (TICA) Programme

Dear Director General,

I am forwarding herewith a set of material/brochures for availing various scholarships under Programme of the Thailand International Cooperation Agency (TICA) for the year 2016-17.

2. I would like to inform that this Mission has been pursuing the matter for our scholars to study in the fields of fisheries (aqua culture), food industrial sciences, gemstone jewelry and industrial development, and post-graduate nursing education under TICA Scholarship Scheme. However, TICA needs our requirements in these fields from Ministry of Food Security, Ministry of Commerce and Ministry of Health. Our side should mention their requirement and tailor courses accordingly i.e. 1 year course, 2 year Master Degree Course etc.

3. It is requested that the requirements of Pakistan with regard to above mentioned faculties may be immediately sent to the Thai Embassy in Islamabad under intimation to this Embassy. This may be sent on the prescribed form enclosed separately. This information is essential for TICA to work out a number of scholarships and their time period under their scholarship scheme programme for Pakistani students.

4. I would strongly suggest that we should suggest to the Thai Embassy in Islamabad to get 1-2 year scholarship programme in fisheries (aqua culture), food sciences, Gemstone Institute of Thailand.

5. The post-graduate education of nurses' cases may be forwarded to the Ministry of Health for their direct response to the Thai Embassy in Islamabad, under intimation to this Mission, for Pakistan's requirements of training at least 10 Post-graduate scholarships for our nurses.
