

TECHNICAL ADVISORY GROUP MEETING – CERVICAL CANCER STRATEGY AND EMONC IMPROVEMENT PLAN

The Technical Advisory Group (TAG) meeting focused on the EmONC (Emergency Obstetric and Newborn Care) Improvement Plan for Islamabad and the National Cervical Cancer Prevention and Control Framework, with oversight from the Ministry of National Health Services, Regulation, and Coordination (M/o NHSRC), as well as key stakeholders. The HSA and UNFPA experts presented the Cervical Cancer Framework for Pakistan, developed through a process of National and Provincial consultations. The Framework aims to address the growing burden of cervical cancer and improve women's health across the country. The framework was developed collaboratively, involving key stakeholders, healthcare experts, and policymakers, ensuring a comprehensive and strategic approach. The framework sets short, medium, and long-term goals, accompanied by specific sequential activities and time frames, to ensure a systematic and coordinated approach towards achieving the overall objectives.
